


## **Senate Committee on Agriculture** Nutrition & Forestry; 118th Congress

**SNAP** Participation as Percent of Total Population










## Farm Bill: Budget & Spending






### **Crop Insurance Program Costs by Crop Year in Million Dollars** Congressional Budget Office (CBO) May 2022




### **Commodities Programs Outlays by Fiscal Year in Million Dollars** Congressional Budget Office (CBO) May 2022








### The 2018 Farm Bill: An Unusual Experience Comparing Farm Bill Payments to Supplemental/Ad Hoc Payments





# Unprecedented Investment in Conservation & Climate

IRA 2022-Conservation Spending (CBO Sept. 7, 2022)



All of the conservation program spending in the IRA is for "1 or more agricultural conservation practices or enhancements that the Secretary determines directly improve soil carbon, reduce nitrogen losses, or reduce, capture, avoid, or sequester carbon dioxide, methane, or nitrous oxide emissions, associated with agricultural production"


### **The Political Strength of the Farm Bill is in Its Coalition**:

Final results of 2022 midterms: 222 Republicans to 213 Democrats (218 needed for majority); geographic sorting & distribution; farm bill challenges.
